I am pleased to provide you with a budget proposal for improvements to The Goathouse Refuge. Below you will find the individual project's scope and pricing. This is based on 11.24.21 site visit and *List of Repairs*, dated 11.13.21. This is priced as a budget time and material estimate including all labor, materials and supplies.

### **Infirmary - Option #1: New Construction 600sft**

- · Remove entire existing Infirmary building and haul offsite
- · Building layout
- Excavate for footings and concrete slab
- · Place #4 rebar w/chairs
- Pour 3000psi concrete footings
- · Lay 8" solid CMU block wall
- · Apply block wall waterproofing
- Place 6" HDPE foundation drain w/filter fabric sock in washed stone envelope
- Backfill foundation wall
- · Rough grade landscape areas and fine grade for building slab subbase aggregate
- · Place 4in #57 washed stone, vapor barrier, pour and broom finish 4" 3000psi concrete building slab
- · Place closed cell sill plate gasket
- Bolt bottom plate with 5/8" galvanized J-bolts
- Frame 2x4 Infirmary walls
- Frame headers for all doors, windows and openings
- · Place Tyvek building wrap
- · Install T111 wood siding
- Frame 2x8 SYP roof rafters 16" O.C.
- Place 5/8" exterior OSB roof sheathing
- · Rough-in and install HVAC 1.5ton heat pump
- Lay Titanium 25 underlayment with Weathershield Ice and Rain Underlayment along roof overhangs
- Construct gable vent
- Install 40 year architectural shingles, color by owner
- · Install 3ea double hung windows, 4ea interior doors and 1ea exterior door
- · Rough-in electrical outlets and lights per code
- · Insulate walls with R-21 Batt insulation and rafters with R-38 Batt insulation
- · Build boxing including freeze board, soffitt, vent and fascia
- · Prime and paint with 2ea finish coats all exterior trim, windows, doors and boxing
- · Install aluminum gutters and downspouts

### **Infirmary - Option #2: Renovation**

- · Catalogue and record all interior walls, windows, doors/doorways, shelving, etc.
- Remove all window casing, door casing and baseboard
- · Remove all countertop, cabinets
- Remove existing fiberglass reinforced panels (FRP)
- · Remove wall and ceiling sheetrock
- · Remove all batt insulation
- · Remove all three different types of floor covering down to the plywood subfloor

#### Infirmary - Option #2: Renovation: continued

- · Inspect floor, wall and roof framing and report findings to owner
- Install air cleaners and dryers to achieve proper structure humidity levels
- Apply cleaning agents to floors, walls and ceilings
- · Prime all exposed surfaces with Fiberlock, Aftershock EPA Registered Fungicidal Coating
- · Install 6mil vapor barrier on all floors, walls and ceiling
- Install R-13 and R-30 batt insulation on walls and ceilings
- · Hang and finish 1/2" drywall
- · Install new wood trim (baseboard, casing
- · Install new sink and counter
- · Install new base and wall cabinets
- · Prime and paint all new and disturbed surfaces
- · Install new FRP on all walls
- · Install new 37,000btu ductless Fujitsu mini-split
- Install outlets and light fixtures

#### Hot Water Heater, Refuge Building

- Remove existing hot water heater
- · Install and test new 40 gallon hot water heater

#### **Back Door Exit, Refuge Building**

- · Remove entire existing concrete mud slab
- Grade soil to slope 1/4" per foot away from building
- Place 4" washed stone, #67's
- Form, pour and broom finish 4" concrete slab with mesh fibers
- Strip forms and backfill

### Electrical, Miscellaneous in Intake Building, Kitten Cabana, Cabin One, Feral Room and Refuge Building

- Re-hang light fixture, wire and provide switch
- Trouble shoot non-functioning lights and/or outlets
- · Replace circuit breakers as needed
- Analyze circuit load requirements and make recommendations
- · Check GFCI outlets for proper grounding
- · Install flat heat shield and non-climbable metal cover over existing heater
- · Relocate some switches
- · Inspect main electrical panel for correct wiring
- · Install new outlet

### Gas Heaters, Kitten Cabana and Kitchen

· Install 2ea new Infratech gas heaters in each space

### Replace Bathroom, Refuge Building

- · Remove sink, vanity, toilet and flooring
- Remove existing tile shower
- · Remove interior wall between shower and vanity/Half Bath
- Remove all floor covering down to subfloor
- · Inspect floor joists and advise client
